

Iowa State Youth Dual Championships

Tournament Information

DATE: January 4, 2015

SITES: Knoxville High School & Middle School

Time and Format: Wrestling will begin at **9:00 AM**. Based on the number of matches. Based on past experience, we would expect each round to last approximately one hour. Rounds will start ASAP on a rolling time schedule.

Weigh-ins: All weigh-ins will be at the high school. Wrestlers will have two options. Saturday Night weigh-ins will be from 6:00-7:00 PM at the high school, and will be SCRATCH WEIGHT. Sunday morning weigh-ins will be from 7:00-8:00 AM and wrestlers will be given a one-pound allowance, due to the proximity to wrestling. Weigh-ins will be done with singlets on.

ENTRANTS: Will consist of individuals grades K-8. A team shall consist of up to: 4 coaches. All entries **MUST BE RECEIVED BY Wednesday, December 10th, 2014.**

DIVISIONS:

OPEN DIVISION: Teams may include any wrestler **that attends your club**. There are 17 weight classes and a team can have up to **25 wrestlers** on their roster.

WEIGHTS: 50, 55, 60, 65, 70, 75, 80, 85, 90, 96, 102, 110, 120, 130, 140, 160, Hwt (Up to 200 lbs).

THESE ARE SCRATCH WEIGHTS.

Entry Fee: \$400.00 and **NON-REFUNDABLE.**

RULES / FORMAT: The tournament will be organized into multiple pools , with each team competing with the other teams in round robin style within their respective pools. The number of pools and teams per pool will be determined by the number of teams entered. Championship rounds will be determined by pool placement. Each team will get at least 3 duals, preferably at least 4 * Pool assignment will be done by random draw, by a coach of each team. * Wrestlers must be members of the club they are representing, and attend the club minimum once a week. *Wrestlers must be in Kindergarten-8th grade. No 8th grader 16 and over may compete *Your roster can consist of any mix of grades, HOWEVER, you may only wrestle a maximum of 8 seventh or eighth graders in each dual. * All bouts will be 1-1-1 minutes in length. * Certified Officials will be used for all matches * A coin flip before each dual will determine who sends out their wrestler first * All duals will start at the 50-pound division and run in order. *We will not be holding any “exhibition matches”, unless agreed upon by each coach, and it will not hold up the meet in any way.

SCHOOL CLUB DIVISION: Teams must consist of wrestlers that attend the school of the team they are wrestling for. Program sharing agreements based on 2014-15 IAHSAA database will be honored. This division is open to towns with a population of 10,000 or less .

WEIGHTS: 53, 59, 66, 73, 80, 88, 96, 104, 112, 120, 130, 140, HWT (Up To 180 lbs.)

THESE ARE SCRATCH WEIGHTS.

Entry Fee: \$300.00 and **NON-REFUNDABLE**.

RULES / FORMAT: The tournament will be organized into multiple pools , with each team competing with the other teams in round robin style within their respective pools. The number of pools and teams per pool will be determined by the number of teams entered. Championship rounds will be determined by pool placement. Each team will get at least 3 duals, preferably at least 4 * Pool assignment will be done by random draw, by a coach of each team. * Teams must be school / town based. * High School sharing agreements based on the IAHSAA will be honored. * Towns with a population of 10,000 or less.

*Wrestlers must be in Kindergarten-8th grade. No 8th grader 16 and over may compete *Your roster can consist of any mix of grades, **HOWEVER**, you may only wrestle a maximum of 6 seventh or eighth graders in each dual. * All bouts will be 1-1-1 minutes in length. * Certified Officials will be used for all matches * A coin flip before each dual will determine who sends out their wrestler first * All duals will start at the 53-pound division and run in order. *We will not be holding any “exhibition matches”, unless agreed upon by each coach, and it will not hold up the meet in any way.

Dual Meets

a. Six team points shall be scored toward the team total for each contestant who wins by a fall, default, forfeit or disqualification. *Note: A team forfeit shall be scored 60-0 (six points for each weight class).* b. Five team points shall be scored for a technical.

d. Four team points shall be scored for a major decision. e. Three team points shall be scored for a decision.

Breaking Team Ties in Dual Meet Advancement Tournaments

- a. Greater number of victories.
- b. Greater number of six-point victories (including falls, forfeits and defaults and disqualifications).
- c. Greater number of five-point technical falls.
- e. Greater number of major decisions.
- f. Fewest number of matches forfeited.
- g. Greater number of total near-fall points earned. (This should include additional points earned for excessive bleeding or injury when near-fall points are awarded).
- h. Greater number of takedowns.
- i. Greater number of reversals.
- j. Greater number of escapes.
- l. Greater number of stalling points.
- m. Colored disk toss. One team point shall be awarded to the team winning by criteria. The method of recording the score in breaking team ties shall be the score followed by the letter of criteria that broke the tie.

MEDALS AND AWARDS: A team trophy will be awarded for 1st -2nd places , and medals for team members from the top 2 teams We will also award All-State Medals for wrestlers who finish the day undefeated (must win at least 3 matches)

Sportsmanship: Sportsmanship is not encouraged, it is be **REQUIRED**. Unruly fans, coaches, or wrestlers will be removed from the tournament.
